WI-IAT 2011 will be held in Lyon, France. Lyon is the capital city of the Rhône-Alpes region which is one of the most industrialized regions of France. Lyon is the binding force in a dense and well-balanced galaxy of mid-size cities (Grenoble, Chambéry, Saint-Etienne, Annecy, Valence) whose increasingly close relations allow the entire Rhône-Alpes region to shine amongst the most influential regions of Europe.
